



Pope Francis proposed that 2024 be marked as a year dedicated to prayer in preparation for the Jubilee 2025.

A jubilee is a special holy year of grace and pilgrimage in the Catholic Church, it typically takes place once every 25 years.

In Pope Francis' Angelus address, the pope said that a Year of Prayer will be "a year dedicated to rediscovering the great value and absolute need for prayer in one's personal life, in the life of the Church, and in the world."
